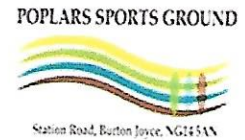


Terms and Conditions of Use - Poplars 3G facility
Free-Play



1. The use of free play is to promote unorganized football with groups of friends to replace grass pitch impromptu play as our pitches become overworked. No training or league matches can take place at these allocated times.
2. In times of overcrowding the BJPC reserves the right to limit use or stagger starts in age groups to give a chance of fair play. For those that have been playing a while please give way to newcomers.
3. As with any random game played on any park these sessions will generally be unsupervised, hence the reason for secure perimeters and controlled access. All access is monitored by BJPC and CCTV cameras are used for prevention of crime, anti-social behaviour and revenue control.
4. Any means of access issued to a user entitles solely that named user to gain entry at agreed times to the Poplars 3G pitch subject to these terms and conditions. Transfer or misuse will result in suspension of that means of access and any access entitlement from it

6. Depending on match fixtures the Pavilion may be open for refreshments.
7. Please act fairly and responsibly to keep this facility in top condition and ensure that mud on boots is not transmitted onto the pitch as it clogs the drainage and the surface. Boots cleaners are at two entrances.
8. Violation of terms, misuse of pitch or cards will result in suspension and removal of access via card cancellation.
9. Any misuse should be reported poplars@burtonjoyceparishcouncil.org.uk or to on-site staff
10. Trainers and studs are permitted footwear– the use of blades is possible but the FA advises that more injuries result from blades on 3G as the larger surface area can cause excessive grip and strain to joints. Blades use is at owner's risk.
11. A spare ball locker will be installed shortly to allow continued play if a ball goes over the fence. The FA do not permit direct access onto grass pitches from 3G to avoid mud on boots contamination of pitch. Replace balls in locker and collect yours at the end of the session
12. To avoid automatic systems lock in, players must clear within 10 minutes of end of sessions and floodlights will switch off
