POP/128	Council members' declarations of interest for items on the agenda - None
POP/129	Election of vice-chair – Cllr T Hazard unanimously elected
POP/130	Minutes of the meeting held on Jan 28th 2019 – unanimously approved as a true record
POP/131	Security /CCTV – 3G CCTV has been repaired. D List sourcing alternative supplier.
POP/132	Poplars Access Working Group – Cllr R Ringham has written letter in response to
	communications with Cllr J Johnson from resident, clarifying the Parish Council's proposal is the
	one which will be pursued. This proposal has been discussed with GBC's Play Pitch Strategy
	consultant and there is potential for funding for it via this route. All Clubs using the Poplars
	Sports Ground have been verbally consulted on the proposal to provide a fenced casual play
	area at the sports ground and have no objections.
POP/133	Aerator – The grant for the aerator from the Premier League and FA Facilities Fund has been
	approved. Cllr P Hyde (Chair) and J Sherrin (Clerk) to sign the agreement and return. BJFC to be
	notified by Cllr R Ringham.
POP/134	3G Steering Group – Notes of meeting held on 26 th February received. Noted FA are very
	supportive and may be able to assist with improving summer usage of the 3G pitch.
POP/135	Cricket Club – Reported that the Club is working on increasing membership numbers. Junior
	fixtures are up this year. D List and Cllr R Ringham to meet with the Club next month.
POP/136	Special Olympics Open Day – Cllr Ringham to chase progress.
POP/137	Sponsorship signs – Unanimously approved for metal sponsorship signs to be erected on pitch 6
	fence, subject to design approval from the committee before installation. Noted signs will be
	inward facing, towards the pitch.
POP/138	Access to Petanque area – Request for more level and even access / path. D List noted there
	had been an issue with badgers digging the ground in this area causing it to be particularly
	uneven. Not feasible to install gravel path, but will endeavour to keep the access as level as
	possible and the grass short.
POP/139	Bowls Pavilion – Issue regarding paving outside the new pavilion under discussion. Bowls Club
	have agreed to pay for lifting equipment necessary to lay 2' x 2' slabs. Cllr Ringham to discuss
	with Club Chairman adherence to Agreement, in particular regarding the Parish Council being
	kept informed of events, following car parking issues for the recent new members signing day.
