Minutes of Meeting held at The Library, Meadow Lane, Burton Joyce, Nottingham on the 4th July 2017 at 10.00am

- 1. Apologies Received: Cllr Hazard and Hutt
- 2. Declaration of Interest: None received
- 3. Minutes form 14th February: Signed and dated as a true record by Chair
- 4. Old School Building (OSB):
 - i. Sub-committee established and will be reporting to main Parish Council
 - ii. 2 replies from residents have been received offering to part of the sub-committee
 - **iii.** Committee requested multipurpose chairs be considered for use when purchasing i.e. light weight, foldable and easy to put up/away.

5. Christmas Light Switch-on:

- i. The date of Saturday 2nd December 2017 was *agreed*.
- **ii**. It was **agreed** to investigate both rental and purchase of suitable marquee for the use of the Brass Band to perform in.
- **iii.** It was **agreed** Christmas Lights Switch-on would be via the OSB (electricity supply directly from OSB).
- iv. It was *agreed* the Brass Band, School and Adult Choir would be contacted to confirm availability
- iv. It was agreed to contact John Jackson regarding the transport for the arrival of Santa
- v. It was *agreed* to contact FRASP for the use of PA system for Brass Band, Choirs and announcement for Countdown to Santa and lights switch-on.
- vi. In principle, the Landlord of the Cross Keys would be invited to host the Christmas Food Fair and gift stalls in the Cross Keys Car park.
- vii. The Parish Council *agreed* it does not have the resources to organise a complete Christmas Fair including a Food Fair and the set up/organisation of Gift Stalls. But it was *agreed* the Parish Council would undertake the switch-on of the Festive lights, the arrival of Santa and associated liaisons, along with road closure/traffic diversions and entertainment by the Brass Band and Choirs.

6. Emergency Plan:

- i. It was agreed the Container at the Cemetery would be considered as a storage facility
- ii. It was **noted** John Jackson has offered usage of large farm vehicles should an emergency arise iii. It was **agreed** to discuss small emergency provisions with Cllr Hutt

7. Village Litter Pick

Poor response to last Litter-pick in April 2017. Suggested date of April 2018. Litter-picker sticks to be provided from Parish Council if required.

8. Highways and Transport

- i. Bus-stop clearways proposed from Via. 19 metres clearway where no traffic can stop (with the obvious exception of buses). *No comments or issues were noted.*
- ii. Resurfacing of Padleys Lane has been completed and the improvements have been noted.
- iii. Burton Joyce Village Society will be writing to Highways suggesting a speed limit of 30 mph to be considered on Nottingham Road. *This suggestion was noted*.

9. Burton Joyce Primary School

No update received. It was **agreed** Deputy Clerk to contact School Secretary regarding Christmas Lights Switch-on.

11. Mineral Extraction Update:
