- i) October 2nd 2018 approved as a true record and signed by the Chair
- ii) Matters arising (not covered by the agenda for information only) Meeting with Garden Holders Association committee representatives and Parish Council Chair, Vice Chair and Clerk organised for November 8th 2018. Outcomes to be reported at next Full Council. Clerk to seek further information on local government reorganisation in Nottinghamshire. To invite GBC Leader and Deputy Leader to present at future Full Council on the subject.
- **18/1554** Opportunity for questions from members of the public (15 minutes) No members of the public present.
- 18/1555 County Councillor's report Regarding the proposed local government reorganisation, cross-party consultation began but has broken down. Thanks were given by Cllr Brooks to the staff and volunteers for such a successful and well-attended Fireworks night. Main Street re-surfacing is going ahead as planned before April 2019. Following a site survey it will now be fully re-surfaced (instead of micro-asphalted). The capital budget has now been agreed and there are no plans to carry out any other requests made for Burton Joyce, however Cllr Brooks will continue to put pressure on NCC. She has also given her full support to the action group requesting a pedestrian crossing on the A612.
- **18/1556**Borough Councillor's report The Borough Council has a new CEO, Carol Bradford. Cllr Doyle has also given his full support to the proposed crossing on the A612. Works on the Gedling Access Road will commence in the summer of 2019 and will take approximately 18 months.
