POP/171	Apologies for absence – None received
POP/172	Council members' declarations of interest for items on the agenda - None
POP/173	Minutes of the meeting held on July 22 nd 2019 – Approved as a true record and duly signed by the Chair
POP/174	CCTV – Ducting and replacement of 2 cameras to be undertaken on 1 st October.
POP/175	Sports Ground Hire Rates – Recommend to increase by 2.7% (RPI) rounded to the nearest 10p, with effect from 1^{st} October.
POP/176	Tea-bar / Bar – Recommend to increase all 80p and 90p sweets and soft drinks and all beer and wine by 10p. Premium gin to increase by 15p and all other spirits and mixers to increase by 25p. To take effect 1 st October.
POP/177	Poplars Access Working Group – Grant application in progress. Noted the placement of goal post in The Grove park over the summer was successful.
POP/178	Meeting with BJFC – Period of the fixed rate for the Club agreed and to be placed on all invoices to ensure clarity of duration. Request for a display cabinet and noticeboard in the Pavilion lounge was considered. Concluded that a noticeboard can be placed outside. Location to be agreed. Request to increase capacity for further expansion of the club was discussed. Cllr Ringham reported his discussion with Severn Trent regarding the land beside the Poplars Sports Ground and noted this has been allocated for a 5 year 'Nectar' programme of wild flower planting, which is in its first year. The verti-drain aerator will allow for more matches to be played on the existing facility once it has had time to take effect. It was concluded that the Parish Council already provides sufficient football facility to more than meet the needs of the village.
