Noted that NCC has only 1 gulley cleaning machine for the entire county. A second one is on order. She has been dealing with many cases regarding the recent floods and had a meeting with the Friends of Roberts' Recreation group and donated the remainder of the divisional fund to them. Cllr Brooks is also working with Southwell Diocese regarding VE Day Celebrations.
