**22/2012** Borough Councillor's report — Cllr Smith provided an update. New safety railings have been installed at the end of Tim Lane. Cllrs Smith and Adams attended the opening of the Gedling Access Road. The Village Lunch group have been given a £576 grant from the Councillors' fund to pay for room hire for the year. (Noted that a room for the Village Lunch group was previously provided free of charge by the Church). The road sign for Maris Drive has been replaced. Damaged lamppost from crash has been reported to highways. Noted location of Maris Drive bus stop needs to be reviewed. Meeting has been organised with EMR regarding train service. Information regarding the name change of Lendrum Court requested. ANPR cameras should be installed on A612 soon.

#### 22/2014 Correspondence –

VIA Double yellow lines consultation — All proposals supported, with the exception of the OSB/Co-op section of Chestnut Grove. Proposed to recommend double yellows on Co-op side of the road rather than the Carnarvon side to ease difficulties entering and exiting properties on Chestnut Grove. Discussion regarding more bollards on grass verges — agreed that parking issues for whole village to be added to next Communities Committee agenda.

*CLW Academy Concerns* – Cllr Smith provided some background to the restructuring of the academies. A review is taking place on 25<sup>th</sup> April. Staff consultation has been recommended but is not enforceable. Details of regional commissioner to be forwarded to the Clerk to pass onto those concerned.

*Ukrainian Flag Request* – Approved 5 for 1 abstention to purchase and fly a flag. *Reinstatement of pavements from Lendrum Court works* – Agreed for Cllr King to write strong letter to managing director of contractor responsible and to copy in Cllr S Smith to pick up with GBC planning officer to ensure the contractor's obligations are fulfilled. *Invitation to Town & Parish Council Engagement Sessions in May 2022* – Cllrs L King and Y Greenfield and Clerk to attend on 26<sup>th</sup> May.
