teacher re: litter picking and poor parking.

CE18/078 Brass Band Picnic in the Park – Standing orders were suspended and

subsequently reinstated to bring this item forward on the agenda to allow David Sheath to participate. Picnic in the Park event to take place 2:30-4:30 Saturday July 14th in The Grove. The Brass Band is producing the poster to advertise the event. Forwarding to J Sherrin when complete. Event to be included in Parish Council submission to Parish Magazine in addition to Brass Band's own advert. Tickets to be sold on the gate priced at £6 Adults £3 children and £15 family. Cllrs volunteered to be on the gate. Band have own 3m x 2m gazebo. Request 24 folding chairs and 2 folding tables from Parish Council. J Sherrin to investigate cost of porta-loo and apply for GBC funding for it. Ice-cream van to be booked providing it can be far enough away from the band for the engine noise not to



interfere with the concert. In event of heavy rain, event will be cancelled – David Sheath to make that decision and advise J Johnson and J Sherrin on the day.
